Dear Friends of IPM,

Redemption and salvation are powerfully displayed through the parable of the prodigal son: ". . . [he] gathered all together, journeyed to a far country, and there wasted his possessions with prodigal living" (Luke 15:13). In rebellion against his father, far from home, and entangled with the godless world, he ended up facing desperate consequences. "Then he went and joined himself to a citizen of that country, and he sent him into his fields to feed swine" (verse 15). In the pangs of guilt and conviction, he turned in repentance toward his father. "I will arise and go to my father, and will say to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you'" (verse 18). His father accepted him with joyous forgiveness: "for this my son was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found" (verse 24).

This profoundly pictures the forgiveness and new birth that our heavenly Father granted us as we turned to Him in repentance. Such glorious salvation is only available through the powerful work of the blood of Christ shed for us upon the cross. "But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ . . . In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace" (Ephesians 2:13; 1:7).

All of us who have trusted in the Lord, including prisoners, have entered into this great salvation that is provided for us by the Blood of Jesus Christ. We can now rejoice in

the following truths: "I will never leave you nor forsake you" (Heb. 13:5). "Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest" (Matt. 11:28). "Casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7). What a wonderful, faithful, loving God we serve.

Dear IPM, I would like to give my testimony. I was a gangmember, drug addict and dealer, and alcoholic. I have been in and out of prison my whole life. This is not something I am proud of, but it is the road my sinful life took me down. I had tried everything to quit using drugs and nothing worked. I was considered one of the worst in prison, as Paul would say, I was the chief sinner. This trip to prison I was placed in Ad-Seg, due to gang involvement and violence. This was solitary confinement, meaning I had no contact with anyone else. Any time I was taken out of my cell, I was handcuffed and shackled.



In fact, Ad-Seg turned out to be a blessing. The Lord had to bring me to a place where I would slow down and heed His calling while there. I gave my life over to the Lord and accepted His free gift of salvation. He delivered me from drugs and alcohol. I still have a lot of growing to do, but I have truly begun to change for the better. I actually have a conscience now and consider the feelings of others, how my actions affect those around me, and try to do the right thing. I have renounced my gang affiliation and serve the Lord now. Through the grace of God I was released back into general population and have a good record of conduct. People know how I lived before coming to Christ and see this change. This change has allowed me to be an effective witness for Christ. I give the Lord all the glory and realize He is truly a God of love Who will transform lives.

Thank you for the Practical Bible Dictionary/Concordance. I use it in the Bible courses I am taking. God has called me to be a Christian Drug and Alcoholic Counselor. I want to help these young gangmembers because I would not listen to counselors while growing up due to my distorted views. I did not think they understood what my life had been. If one life is changed, all the misery of my past will be worth it. These young gang-members look up to us older convicts, but I want them to look up to Jesus Christ and find real joyful life.


