## The Testimony of Chaplain Ray

> "The Lord has sent me . . to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that our bound" - Isaiah 61:1

Chaplain Ray saw the miracle transformation that had occurred in his friend, Ron Bayles, an ex-convict. Ron's life became so totally transformed, he was like an entirely new person. At the age of 19, Chaplain Ray surrendered his life to Christ and discovered that "when you meet Christ and Christ comes into your life, and makes you a new creature, it's no longer you, but it's Christ in you the hope of glory, and the earnest of what is to come. When we believe in our heart on the Lord Jesus and confess with our mouth the Lord Jesus, that God hath raised Him from the dead, that we will be saved, and that we are saved. He never turns any away."

Chaplain Ray would say regarding prisoners that, "Prisoners often feel rejected. They feel hopeless; they feel helpless. Don't ever give up on any prisoner. As long as there's life, there's hope. As long as God lives, there is hope in Him for a changed life." When anyone would ask him, "Why do you want to waste your life on prisoners? What can they do for you?" He would respond, "Prisoners don't have to do anything for me. One of them did it all a long time ago. And it has lasted all these years."
