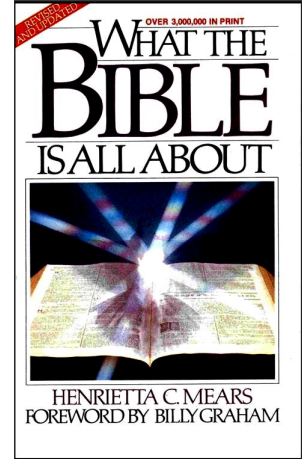
What the Bible is All About

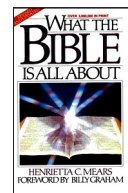
