If Jesus is Knocking at My Door, I Shall Answer




Arrested in the Kingdom

Oswaldo Magdangal knew the dangers of holding Christian Bible studies and worship meetings in Saudi Arabia. But Oswaldo, known by his friends as "Pastor Wally," decided to stay and pray. The knock at the door finally came—the religious police had arrived. This is the story of Oswaldo's arrest, torture, and trust in God as Christmas Day 1992 drew nearer, the day on which he was due to be hanged.

"The following is an account of my experience as a Christian in a country that has yet to embrace the love of God in Christ. Without Jesus in my life this experience is meaningless. But because of Jesus Christ in me this experience proves the reality of God, His love, His power, His supernatural attributes as well as His abundant grace. Without Jesus Christ in my life everything would be meaningless. But because of Jesus Christ I have found meaning to life in this world, no matter what this world does to someone who loves God. 
