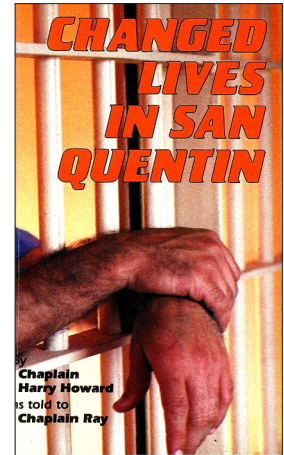

John Bishop started reading the Bible in his cell. He spent many hours thinking about how he had missed the mark by not knowing more about Jesus. Then one day another prisoner who was ministering cell to cell led John in the Sinner’s Prayer and he accepted Jesus into his life. “From that time on,” John declared, “I spent a lot of time reading my Bible. I began to get a handle on it, and my life started changing dramatically.” John became a “cell minister.” After his parole, John went back into San Quentin to continue in cell ministry. He said, “When I am in front of a cell with one of the men, it is like looking into a mirror and seeing myself. Maybe it is because I have been in the same position without any of the answers. It is glorious when I can share the truth of Christ with a man and pray with him. I know what Jesus can do, and He has made me part of His miracle.”

Bill Dixon says: “For a year and a half I studied my Bible behind those grim San Quentin bars. God changed my cell. It was no longer a place of captivity.” Bill’s entire life was turned around through his faith in Jesus and by applying God’s word to his own life. The hatred, violence and life of crime was gone.
