Dear Friends of IPM,

As we follow Christ in this fallen world, we often find ourselves crying out for the Lord's peace in the midst of turmoil and His strength in the midst of impossibilities. We recently received a prayer request from Donovan M., in an Ohio prison. Donovan wrote: "Pray that I will find the peace that surpasses understanding and that God gives me the strength I need to press forward."

How can we know the perfect peace of God within our hearts? "And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus...Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee" (Philippians 4:7; Isaiah 26:3). When we rely upon and trust in the Lord, His goodness brings forth peace in our lives. His peace is able to guard our hearts and minds and provide us with perfect inner rest. This peace can only be experienced as we fix our minds on Him, not on our circumstances. We must fix our eyes upon Jesus, hoping in Him, seeking Him, and trusting in Him.

Where can we find the strength needed to press forward? "But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint" (Isaiah 40:31). If we are in need of spiritual strength, we shouldn't try to muster up our own strength, which is completely inadequate. This is God's reminder to seek His supply of strength. To receive this power, we must admit our own weaknesses. We must wait upon the Lord. This waiting involves hoping in Him and placing our expectations upon Him, not upon ourselves.
