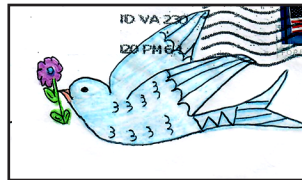

“If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; and ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free”

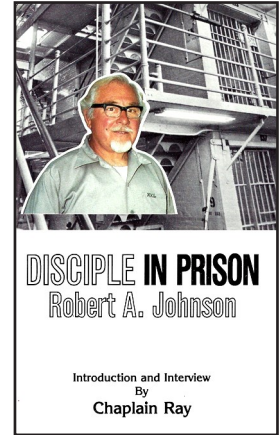
- John 8:31-32

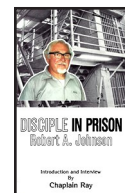
Robert Johnson’s testimony has been a blessing to thousands of inmates over the years. He truly was a Disciple in Prison.
