Dear Friends of IPM,

God desires each of His followers to grow in a life of obedience unto Him. We recently received a letter from David L., in a Georgia prison. David wrote: "Pray that the Lord will direct me to lead a life which is pleasing and obedient to Him."

It is the will of God that we learn to walk in a manner pleasing to the Lord. "That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing (fully pleasing Him), being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God" (Colossians 1:10). Many people waste their lives living to please themselves. Living to please self will never lead to spiritual growth and Christ-likeness. Living to please God is what we were created for. Such Godly living can only be developed by faith. "But without faith it is impossible to please him..." (Hebrews 11:6). Al Capone's Devil Driver


"Submit yourselves therefore to God..." - James 4:7
