Dear Friends of IPM,

As we follow Christ in this fallen world, we often find ourselves crying out for the Lord's peace in the midst of turmoil and His strength in the midst of impossibilities. We recently received a prayer request from Donovan M., in an Ohio prison. Donovan wrote: "Pray that I will find the peace that surpasses understanding and that God gives me the strength I need to press forward."

How can we know the perfect peace of God within our hearts? "And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus...Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee" (Philippians 4:7; Isaiah 26:3). When we rely upon and trust in the Lord, His goodness brings forth peace in our lives. His peace is able to guard our hearts and minds and provide us with perfect inner rest. This peace can only be experienced as we fix our minds on Him, not on our circumstances. We must fix our eyes upon Jesus, hoping in Him, seeking Him, and trusting in Him.

Where can we find the strength needed to press forward? "But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint" (Isaiah 40:31). If we are in need of spiritual strength, we shouldn't try to muster up our own strength, which is completely inadequate. This is God's reminder to seek His supply of strength. To receive this power, we must admit our own weaknesses. We must wait upon the Lord. This waiting involves hoping in Him and placing our expectations upon Him, not upon ourselves.

We can trust in Him to supply these needs in our lives. Like Donovan, may we continue to look to the Lord for what only He can provide.

We thank the Lord for all of our dear ministry partners. Through your faithful partnership and the Lord's enablement, we will continue to reach out to needy souls, pointing them to the One who is able to pour out His perfect peace and strength into their lives.

"But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ" - 1 Corinthians 15:57


At age two, Donald ("Big D") Garcia lost his father in a gangland slaying. Donald was forced to fight to protect himself. As a gang leader and middleweight champion, he was frequently imprisoned, but God wouldn't let him go.

Some believe miracles don't happen, but this real-life story conclusively proves otherwise. Donald Garcia was a gang leader who spent over a third of his life in prison. With each incarceration, he became harder and meaner. When out of prison, he was often charged with other crimes, including murder. Heroin and cocaine kept him in an angry fog. But when the God of awesome surprises transformed him, Donald ("Big D") became a life-changer to the gangs he once led.

Today Donald Garcia helps set gang members free through his own personal ministry—a powerful, faith-based outreach to both the streets and prisons.
