Dear Friends of IPM,

The Lord wants us to have a godly perspective, to think as He thinks, to set our minds on things above. We recently received a letter from Zachary M., in a Missouri prison. Zachary wrote: "Thank you for all you're doing for me with the books you provide. They help me so very much to keep my mind on things above."

It is the Lord's will that we set our minds on things above. "If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth" (Colossians 3:1,2). We are to be seeking things which are spiritual and eternal, setting our affections on things above, not on the things of this earth. We are not to be pursuing a life of fleshly living or fleshly indulgence.

How is it possible to set our minds on things above more and more? The Lord does this work in us by renewing our minds. "And be renewed in the spirit of your mind...And do not be conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind..." (Ephesians 4:23; Romans 12:2). We need to be renewed in the spirit of our minds. Further, we need every aspect of our minds renewed. This involves learning to think God's way. It is the opposite of being conformed to this world. When we become a Christian, Jesus is not just added to our life, He becomes our life. The more we get to know Him, the more we will find ourselves seeking what pleases Him and honors Him.

The word of the Lord is the basic means He uses to transform us and renew our minds. God calls us to feed upon His

word so that His word may go to work transforming our hearts and minds. "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness..." (Matthew 6:33). In everything we do, we are to seek Him first, in His word and in prayer. In every day, in every situation, our hearts and minds are to be anchored in Him, seeking Him, and looking to Him.

As we grow in this transforming work of God, and as our minds become renewed by feeding upon His word, we will find ourselves, like Zachary, setting our minds on things above. May the Lord continue to renew hearts and minds, both inside and outside prison walls. We praise the Lord for all who partner with us in sharing God's love and truth to countless hungry souls behind bars.


