Dear Friends of IPM,

This month we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. According to the Scriptures, all who believe in the Lord are united with him through His death, burial and resurrection.

From God's perspective, we who trusted in Jesus Christ died on the cross with Him and were buried in the tomb with Him. "[You were] buried with him in baptism...we have been planted together in the likeness of his death..." (Colossians 2:12a; Romans 6:5a). When we first believed on the Lord Jesus, we were joined to Him, made one with Him, identified with Him through His death, burial and resurrection. Water baptism bears testimony to this truth. In God's sight, our old life was crucified and buried.

Through faith in Christ and our identification with Him, we were also raised from the tomb with Jesus. "...wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead" (Colossians 2:12b). Just as His death became our death through identification, so also His resurrection became our resurrection. "For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection" (Romans 6:5). In God's sight, we have been raised to a new life in Christ. "Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father. also should walk in newness even so we life" (Romans 6:4). He has made us alive together with Him. We can rejoice in His saving grace! By the power of His resurrection, He is able to lead us in the reality of newness of life.


The Lord knows what He is going to do with us long before we have any inkling of it.
