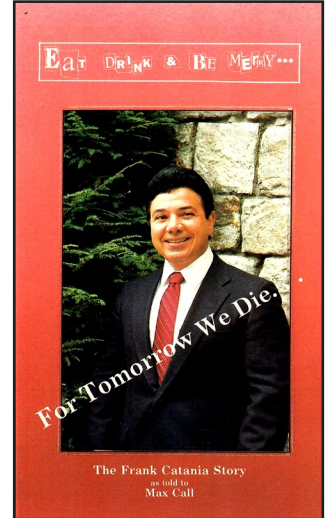

Frank wasted years of his life before Jesus found him. He lived a life serving himself and no one else. But when Jesus entered his heart, and he felt the power of love and forgiveness, all that changed. We praise the Lord for all who partner with IPM through their faithful prayers and generous giving which enable IPM to continue to share God’s love and truth with those behind bars.

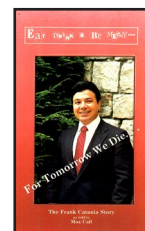

Dear Friends of IPM,
