Our Mighty and Powerful Lord and Savior Came into My Heart

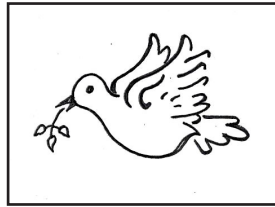

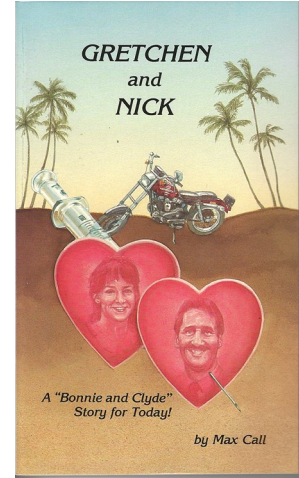
Gretchen and Nick

We praise the Lord for all who partner with IPM through their faithful prayers and generous giving which enable IPM to continue to share God's love and truth with those behind bars.

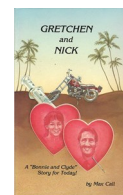
